Descendant of his grandmother Anaslaga, from the Raven clan of the Tlingit people of Alaska, Ted now works in Coast Salish territory on Southern Vancouver Island. He works in the education field, primarily in his role with the Cowichan Valley School District, and as a sessional lecturer for first and second year education students in the Native Indian Teacher Education Program for the University of British Columbia. Ted works closely with the Ministry of Education's Aboriginal Enhancement Branch to facilitate change in the way School Districts in British Columbia serve Aboriginal students. His journey has taken him far from the beautiful people and land of Tsaxis, but his heart remains there.
